




I'm Hungry!

- Point to the hearts as you say the number.




Old MacDonald had a Farm

- Use your voice, fingers and hands as you count the animals.




Where is the **Green Sheep?**

- Talk about the opposites shown by the sheep.




Maisy's Bedtime

- You can talk about colours and actions.




Dear Zoo

- Your child will enjoy this book over and over, becoming familiar with the words that are repeated.




Toddlerobics Animal Fun

- Find a particular toddler on each page.




Spot Goes on Holiday
