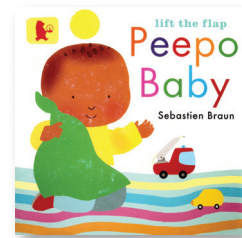

- Your baby will enjoy the pictures of other babies.

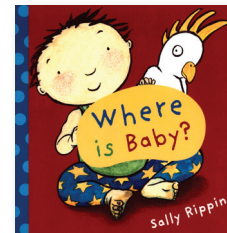


Where is Baby?

- Help your baby turn the pages.

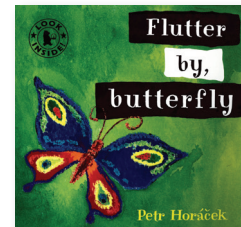


Flutter by, butterfly

- Lots of fun new words.

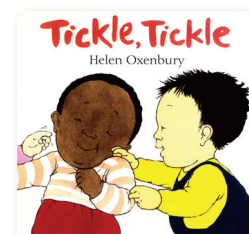


Tickle, Tickle

- Repeat words from the book when playing with your baby e.g. "splish, splash, scrub-a-dub" when your baby is in the bath.

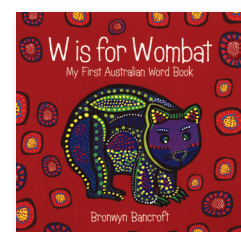

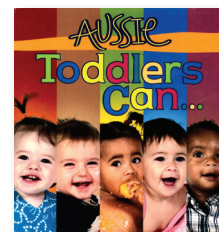
- Emphasise the rhyming words.

- Your baby will love the pictures of babies and the mirror to look in to.

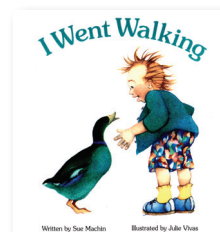

- Each time you read, find another animal.

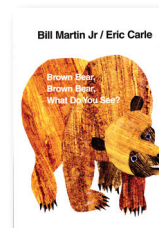


Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See?

- Talk about the colours.

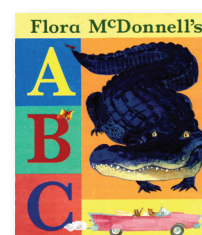
